Key Responsibilities:

- Plan, manage and oversee daily transport operations across Northern Ireland and ROI.
- Schedule driver routes and loads in the most efficient and cost-effective manner.
- Ensure all drivers operate within legal and safety requirements (e.g., EU drivers' hours, tachograph regulations).
